I certify that I meet one of the eligibility requirements, meet all qualifications, and have read/understand the terms and conditions. I certify that I will abide by the following conditions if selected as a scholarship recipient:

1. Scholarship funds are to be used within the 2024-2025 academic year (Fall, Spring, and/or Summer semesters) at an accredited college, university, vocational, technical or trade school.
2. As a scholarship recipient, if chosen, I understand that I must provide the name and address of the school where I am accepted for the 2024-2025 academic year (Fall, Spring, and Summer semesters), i.e. verification form and proof of enrollment (i.e. class schedule) to the scholarship committee by 1 September 2025. Unclaimed funds will revert to the ESC Scholarship Fund.
3. Scholarship funds are to be applied to tuition, fees, room and board, and books at an accredited college, university, or technical school.
4. The ESC scholarship, when combined with other scholarships, must not exceed the cost of tuition, fees, room and board, and books for the applicable academic year. I agree that any remaining funds must be returned to the ESC Scholarship Committee as soon as possible.
5. If I accept an appointment to a military service academy or a **FULL** scholarship (to include tuition, fees, room and board, and books), I understand I will be ineligible for this ESC scholarship award and must notify the Edwards Spouses Club within 30 calendar days. I agree that any funds must be returned to the ESC Scholarship Committee as soon as possible.
6. If I receive the GI Bill or accept a scholarship from another military officers'/ enlisted spouses' organization that pays **FULL** tuition, fees, room and board, and books, I understand I will be ineligible for this ESC scholarship and will need to notify the Edwards Spouses Club Scholarship Chair immediately. I agree that any funds must be returned to the ESC Scholarship Committee as soon as possible.
7. I am a responsible citizen in good standing in the school and the community.
8. It is my responsibility to notify the ESC Scholarship Committee of any change of status (e.g., change of schools, change in address, acceptance of full scholarship, etc.) Failure to do so may result in the forfeiture of my scholarship award.
9. If any of the above conditions are violated, scholarship funds must be returned to the ESC Scholarship Committee.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION CHECKLIST OF ITEMS TO BE SUBMITTED

This application becomes complete and valid only when all the items listed below are complete/delivered. The completed scholarship package must all be submitted or postmarked by 19 January 2024.

Completed ESC scholarship application (this document).

Each page of completed scholarship application has the last 4 of Applicant's SSN.

**Essay written: "Why is continuing your education important to you, and what made you decide on the school/program you have chosen?" Use criteria below.

Choose 1 of the following:

- **Essay: "Describe a topic, idea, concept, or passion you find so engaging, it makes you lose track of time. Why does it captivate you? What or who do you turn to when you want to learn more?" Use criteria listed below.

OR

- **Essay: "Describe how the military lifestyle, or your affiliation with the military, has impacted your view of society, culture, or future goals?" Use criteria listed below.

OR

- **PowerPoint presentation: "Why have you chosen your future program, if you are an artist, feel free to show your work, photography, forensics, etc. (minus self-identifiers)" – in this option there is availability to show your work or interest. Use criteria listed below.

Transcripts supporting all educational data and documenting your GPA at the end of the first semester of your current school year (Note: unofficial transcripts will be accepted). If unofficial transcripts are not available for Fall 2023 academic semester, other timestamped grades/GPA documentation may be accepted.

Two (2) completed recommendations. It is recommended to ask people who are acquainted with the applicant's entire background, especially their scholastic achievement, to complete the forms. The recommendations may not come from family members.

Place your SSN (Last 4 ONLY) in the upper right corner and word count at the end of the essay(s) and/or PowerPoint. **DO NOT use your name, school, position, pictures of self, or other self-identifiers**

Essay and PowerPoint will be reviewed based on:

1. Organization and Structure – thesis, introduction, body, conclusion, and transitions
2. Mechanics – grammar, spelling, punctuation, and sentence structure
3. Content – consistency, focus, and elaboration
4. Presentation – professional appearance and liberties taken for creativity

Essay: 300-500 words

PowerPoint: 10 slides or less
